Infrared Thermometers are Essential to the Job

With all the focus on health and safety regarding Covid 19, I have been doing research on thermometers for my employees. This focus reminded me of the importance of an infrared thermometer while crack sealing.

Save Time

A decent infrared thermometer can cost approximately \$100 and can save a contractor a great deal of time and money on a crack sealant jobsite. P&T Products recommends using an infrared thermometer every time you crack seal. We suggest contractors use the thermometer to verify that the temperature gauges are working on the equipment.



Easy to Use

Simply point the infrared gun to the material in the melter and/or the material as it is hitting the pavement to verify that the application temperature is within the range printed on each box.

The largest contributing factor to the tracking of crack sealant is overheating the material.

Peace of Mind

Take a few seconds at the beginning, and intermittently through the job, to double check the product temperature. Doing this can help prevent callbacks to address tracking, the added expense to correct it, and a tarnished reputation. Bottom line - \$100 is cheap insurance for a job done right!
